OPEN TO FIFE RIDING CLUB MEMBERS ONLY

ENTRY FEE: £5 per class

From 10.00am

Class 1 - Clear Round, max 30cm; each rider to ride **two** rounds.

Class 2 – Clear Round, max 35cm; each rider to ride **two** rounds.

Class 3 – Clear Round, max 45cm; each rider to ride **two** rounds.

Class 4 – Clear Round, max 55cm; each rider to ride **two** rounds.

Class 5 – Max 60cm. First round – Clear Round, second round single phase.

Class 6 – Max 75cm. First round – Clear Round, second round single phase.

Class 7 – Max 85cm. First round – Clear Round, second round single phase.

Class 8 - Max 90cm. First round – Clear Round, second round single phase.

Class 9 – Max 100cm. First round – Clear Round, second round single phase.

PLEASE NOTE:

Classes 1 – 4

Will be run as clear rounds, **each rider will ride two rounds.**

Classes 5 – 9

The course will comprise between 10/12 fences; the first round will be a shortened track of 6/7 fences only; the second round will be run like a **single-phase** competition over all the fences with the latter part of the course being timed.

THIS IS A TRAINING DAY ONLY – NOT A COMPETITION
NO AWARDS WILL BE MADE

ALL RIDERS MUST COMPLY WITH THE CLUBS COVID POLICY.

Participants are responsible for their own Health & Safety and for the safety of other field users, including volunteers. Members should bring their own hand sanitiser and use it regularly. Masks or face coverings must be worn although riders may remove when on horseback. Everyone must adhere to social distancing rules and keep at least 2m apart at all times. Spot checks will be made. RIDERS WILL BE GIVEN AN ALLOCATED TIME and are limited to ONE class ONLY (each class will however be run over two rounds). Riders' paper numbers will not be issued. We are required to operate rider "bubbles" and will not be able to accommodate anyone arriving late. Lorries/trailers to be parked at least 5m apart. The layout of the field will be modified to incorporate a one way system. Numbers of horses in the collecting ring will be restricted and riders must follow stewards' directions. No members of the public allowed in collecting ring. Riders are required to leave the showground within 15 minutes of finishing their class. No spectators allowed. There will be no catering or toilet on the showground.

These changes have been brought in to comply with Scottish Government requirements and to demonstrate that horse riding meetings can operate safely, as promised by the sport's governing bodies.

Failure or refusal to comply with these new protocols will cause the meeting to be abandoned as the safety of members and volunteers is paramount.
