The **Russell Pollock Smith Memorial Trophy** will be awarded to the highest placed FRC member on the day (ONE DAY EVENT CLASSES ONLY). The **Colonial Rule Trophy** will be awarded to the highest placed FRC member in Class 1 (ONE DAY EVENT CLASSES ONLY).

THE COMPETITION WILL BE RUN UNDER FRC RULES. PLEASE OBSERVE HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES AT ALL TIMES

RULES

1. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, alter advertised times or refuse entry where necessary.
2. It is a condition of entry that: -
 - a) All competitors must comply with stewards/judges instructions at all times.
 - b) Any person, when mounted, must wear a riding hat to the minimum standard (see 10, below) and that it be securely fastened at all times.
 - c) Horses must not be exercised, lunged, warmed up, cantered or galloped in the horsebox/car parking area.
 - d) Horses must not enter any area designated a safety zone.
3. Competition Rules (Cross country phase):-
 - a) Knock down = 5 penalties
 - b) 1st refusal = 10 penalties
 - c) 2nd refusal = 20 penalties
 - d) 3rd refusal at same fence = elimination
 - e) 1st fall of rider = 30 penalties
 - f) 2nd fall of rider = elimination
 - g) Failure to complete the course = elimination
4. The dressage & showjumping phases will be marked as per “normal” Horse Trials.
5. Competitors may continue on the cross country course after elimination but must not attempt fences more than three times or obstruct on-coming horses. Anyone abusing this relaxation may be banned from future Fife Riding Club Events.
6. Entries close on Friday 27 JULY. All entries must be accompanied by the appropriate remittance. Make cheques payable to “Fife Riding Club”. There will be no refund of money after closing date unless accompanied by a vet’s certificate.
7. FRC Members: For the avoidance of doubt, the term “member” denotes a fully paid up RIDING, HONORARY or ASSOCIATE MEMBER of Fife Riding Club only. Junior riders (under 16) must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
8. Approximate start times will be available from Friday 3 AUGUST by phoning Linda on 07740027427 between 7 and 9pm ONLY. Alternatively check the “Events” page on the website (www.fife-riding-club.co.uk). Actual start times may vary.
9. The Showjumping course will be open to walk between 4pm and 6pm on Saturday 4 AUGUST or on the day of competition. Under no circumstances will the course be walked before that time. Due to space restrictions the cross country course will only be available to walk on the day of competition during the lunch break; however course plans will be made available earlier.

- 10. Any complaint must be lodged, prior to the Prize giving of that class within 20 minutes of the incident, in writing accompanied with a £20 deposit to the Secretary. The deposit will be refunded if the complaint is upheld or at the discretion of the Organiser. This decision is final.**
- 11. Compulsory equipment to be worn at all times when mounted:**
 - a) Skull Caps (to a minimum EN1384, PAS015), without attached peaks and securely fastened at all times.**
 - b) Body Protector (except dressage)**
 - c) Full Length Riding Boots, Jodhpur Boots or Gaiters with matching boots.**

Warning: You will not be allowed to compete should you fail to wear the above compulsory equipment.
- 12. All horses or ponies must be 5 years old or over and no horse or pony may compete more than once.**
- 13. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on leads at all times.**
- 14. Please ensure that all litter and general debris, i.e. horse poo, drink cans, bandage tapes, straw, etc. are disposed of tidily or taken home.**
- 15. Due to space constraints and Health & Safety matters, competitors must park where directed by steward.**

Toilets will be on the showground. We will endeavour to have a snack van on site however, this will be dependant on the number of entries. The tuck shop will be open should no snack van be available.
